


INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

PART No. 30418 & 30443 MODEL No.

Brush Guard

- 1. Remove the existing four bumper bolts. **DO NOT** remove bumper.
- 2. Mount side plates A and B on the bumper, using four bumper bolts.
- 3. **NOTE:** If you are using a Kentrol bumper, you must use the aluminum spacers on the bottom side of the bumper, between the bumper and side plate of the brush guard. **DO NOT** tighten bolts at this time.
- 4. Put the top cross tube in place and start the 7/16" bolt on the end of side plate A. Repeat for side plate B. Snug the bolts but **DO NOT** tighten.
- 5. The bottom cross tube can now be placed in position and bolted to the side plates.
- 6. There are two holes on each side plate for the bottom cross tube. Choose the best position for your application. Start the 7/16" bolts in each end.
- 7. With all bolts started and in position, tighten the bolts in the side plates, then tighten the four bumper bolts.

Brush Guard

- 8. Remove the existing four bumper bolts. **DO NOT** remove bumper.
- 9. Mount side plates A and B on the bumper, using four bumper bolts.

- 11. Put the top cross tube in place and start the 7/16" bolt on the end of side plate A. Repeat for side plate B. Snug the bolts but **DO NOT** tighten.
- 12. The bottom cross tube can now be placed in position and bolted to the side plates.
- 13. There are two holes on each side plate for the bottom cross tube. Choose the best position for your application. Start the 7/16" bolts in each end.
- 14. With all bolts started and in position, tighten the bolts in the side plates, then tighten the four bumper bolts.
