



- TORQUE WRENCH




### GROSS LOAD CAPACITY WHEN USED AS A WEIGHT DISTRIBUTION HITCH:

6,000 LBS. Trailer weight & 600 LBS. Tongue weight.




**STEP 1:** Remove existing trailer ball hole cap on center of bumper and set aside.




**STEP 2:** Raise the hitch into position and secure with flat head socket cap screw through the bumper and bumper support into the hitch.




**STEP 3:** Insert coiled end of the fishwire tool through hitch mounting hole in vehicle frame tube.




STEP 4: Pull coiled end of the fishwire out of the frame tube hole.




**STEP 5:** Attach bolt plate onto fishwire then insert into frame tube.



**STEP 6:** Pull bolt plate out in hitch mounting hole through frame tube. (Then repeat STEP 3 - 6 for the other bolt plate.)



**STEP 7:** Secure the two bolt plates with washers and nuts. Torque hardware to 100 lb-ft.



**STEP 8:** Torque the flat head socket cap screw to 250 lb-ft. Installation complete.
