1) PREPARING YOUR VEHICLE

Begin by disconnecting your battery prior to starting your installation.

Inspect your vehicle for leaking fuel lines, fuel tank and engine components. If you have fuel leaks repair all leaks prior to starting your installation. If your fuel tank is near your welding area **remove your tank prior to welding.**

Remove all combustible items above the work area such as seats, carpets, padding, etc.

Keep all flammable materials away from the vehicle work area.

2) PREPARING YOUR WORKSTATION

Keep a fire extinguisher close by in the case of fire and make sure you always have a designated "Fire Watch" to assist during the cutting or welding phases.

Abide by all apprenticed welding safety standards and practices.

Always use appropriate welding eye protection, ear protection, and work and fire safety gloves during the installation and within the work area.

3) PREPARING FOR YOUR INSTALL


Lift up your vehicle. Remove any lines or power harnesses from the work area as well as your fuel tank.

Remove your EVAP can using an 13mm socket.

4) **CUT**

Cut out the factory fuel tank crossmember, as well as any obstructions in the work area.





Grind the frame free of rust and debris, revealing bare metal.



Paint the work area with a weld through primer to help prevent against rust development.

5) WELD

Our part features two side plates to fit between the frame rail and the crossmember. Holding the plates up to the frame rail, use the factory crossmember's silhouette to help with the alignment.

C-clamp the plates into place on each side of the frame rail.

Once in place, tac weld the plates onto the frame, making sure the crossmember aligns correctly with the side plates.


Hold your fuel tank crossmember up to the frame. Following proper welding procedure, tac weld the right side of your crossmember to the frame.



Use a hammer to tap the left side into place.



Once in place, finish tac welding the part onto the frame before welding the part on fully. Weld 100% around all edges.



6) **REINSTALL**

Slide your EVAP can back onto your crossmember using the tongue in the center of your crossmember to hold the bracket in place.

NOTE: If the fit is too tight on your EVAP bracket, you will need to clean up and remove the rust before proceeding to ensure a good fit.



With the included hardware, reinstall your EVAP can with an 13mm socket.

7) PAINT AND PROTECT

Paint the part with primer or other rust inhibitor to help prevent or reduce the risk of rust formation.

We recommend our Rust Buster Rust Converter & Primer Spray Paint (RB9917).







8) REINSTALL

Reinstall your fuel tank.
