

Removal of Stock Exhaust:

- 1. Loosen each bolt holding the muffler to the frame.
- 2. Loosen the clamp holding the muffler to the header pipe.
- 3. To remove the muffler from the bike, the header has to be unbolted from the engine.

Installation of MBRP Inc. Exhaust:

- 1. Hang the new **Muffler** and the **Inlet Pipe** from the bike mounts **as shown in Figure 1.**
- 2. Slide the band **Clamp** over the **Inlet Pipe** inlet.
- 3. Connect the header to the new exhaust system and tighten the header bolts on the engine.
- 4. Tighten the band **Clamp** on the **Inlet Pipe** inlet.


