

Removal of Stock Exhaust:

- 1. Using a 10mm socket, remove the heat shield covering the stock muffler inlet. **Refer to Figure 1.**
- 2. Remove the springs securing the muffler inlet to the exhaust pipe. Do not discard the springs.
- 3. Remove the springs attached to the support bracket on the bottom of the muffler. Do not discard the springs. **Refer to Figure 2.**
- 4. Remove the muffler by sliding the hangers out of the rubber insulators and past the heat shield.

Installation of MBRP Exhaust:

- 1. Slide the **Muffler** hangers through the heat shield opening and into the rubber insulators on the bike.
- 2. Install the **Inlet Pipe** onto the end of the **Muffler** inlet, securing it using the supplied **Spring**. **Refer to Figure 3**.
- 3. Place the cupped end of the **Inlet Pipe** onto the end of the exhaust pipe and secure it using the springs that were removed from the stock exhaust. **Refer to Figure 4.**
- 4. Ensure that the lower muffler support bracket is sitting in the correct position and then re-install the two springs that were removed from the stock muffler. **Refer to Figure 5.**
