





1. Remove the OEM tip and spark arrestor from the OEM muffler.
2. Remove both upper sway bar links from the sway bar. Lower the bar down to provide clearance for muffler removal.  
**Refer to Figure 1.**
3. Remove the muffler inlet and exhaust pipe heatshields.
4. Remove 2 bolts along the bottom of the lower turbo heatshield. Remove the shield.  
**Refer to Figure 2.**
5. Remove 4 bolts along the top of the upper turbo heatshield at the cylinder head. Lift the shield to expose the V band Clamp.  
**Refer to Figure 3.**
6. Remove all exhaust springs followed by the v-band clamp. Disconnect the O2 sensor wiring and remove the exhaust pipe.
7. Remove 4 bolts from the OEM muffler mount and remove the assembly from the left side of the SxS.

## Installation of MBRP Exhaust:

1. Remove the O2 sensor from the OEM exhaust and install on the **Muffler Assembly**.  
**Refer to Figure 4.**
2. Place the OEM V-Band Clamp over the flare on the **Muffler Assembly** before installing it. Secure it with the previously removed stock bolts through the mounting bracket and into the stock mounts. NOTE; Only 3 of the 4 mounting points are used.  
**Refer to Figure 5.**
3. Tighten the V-Band clamp being sure the pilot diameter of the flare is properly located inside the turbo housing. Reconnect the O2 sensor connector.
4. Install the **M8 Panel Nut** onto the tip's center mounting bracket. Install the OEM Spark Arrestor into the outlet of the **Muffler Assembly** followed by the OEM Tip. Secure the Tip in position with the previously removed hardware.  
**Refer to Figures 6, 7, and 8.**
5. Re-install the upper turbo heatshield followed by the lower turbo heatshield with the previously removed hardware.
6. Re-Install both upper sway bar links.

**Note:** In order to maintain optimal performance, the spark arrestor screen should be cleaned after the **first 3 hours of use**. Afterwards, clean every 30 – 35 hours of use.
