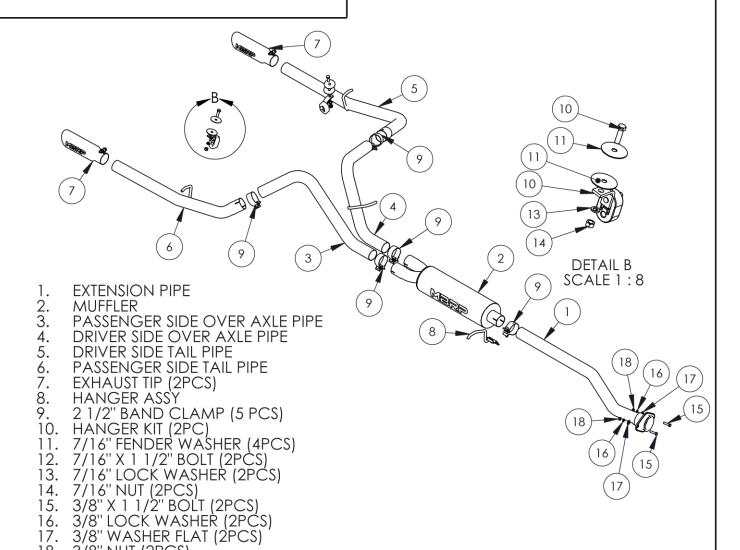

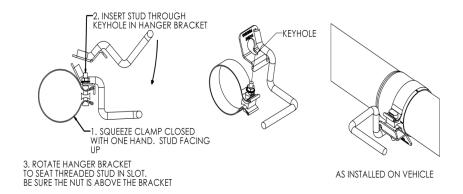

Removal of Stock System:

- 1. Apply a penetrating lubricant liberally to all exhaust fasteners, hangers, and rubber insulators.
- 2. Remove the nuts from the studs holding the front flange together and disconnect exhaust system.
- 3. Remove the hangers from the rubber insulators and remove the exhaust from the vehicle. **Refer to Figure 1**. If a hoist or hydraulic lift is not being used the tail pipe may need to be cut to clear the rear axle.
- 4. The studs located in the exhaust flange must be removed. This can be accomplished using a hammer. The studs will be replaced by hardware supplied with the system. Refer to Figure 2.

Installation of MBRP Inc. Performance Exhaust

- 1. Loosely attach the Extension Pipe at the flange using the hardware provided. **Refer to Figure 3.**
- 2. Loosely install the **Hanger Tight**TM **Clamp** around the front of the **Muffler** and into the factory rubber insulator located on the frame near the end of the **Extension Pipe**. **Refer to Figure 4**.
- 3. Install the **Hang TightTM** Hanger onto a **2.5**" **Band Clamp** using the procedure shown below. (Hang TightTM Hanger not exactly as shown)



4. Install the **Muffler** onto the **Extension Pipe** with the outlets set horizontally. Loosely install the **Driver Side Over Axle Pipe** using a 2 ½" **Clamp** to connecting it to the outlet closest to the drive shaft. Install the hanger into the rubber insulator located above the **Muffler** outlets. **Refer to Figure 6.**

- 5. Feed the Passenger Side Over Axle Pipe over the axle and install it loosely into the left side of the Muffler using a 2 ½" Clamp. Refer to Figure 7.
- 6. Feed the expanded end of the **Driver Side Tail Pipe** from the rear of the vehicle above the axle, around the outside of the shock absorber and connect it to the **Driver Side Over Axle Pipe** using a 2 ½" Clamp. Refer to Figure 9.
- 7. Move the **Driver Side Tail Pipe** into approximate position. Using the factory hole in the frame located directly above the tail **Driver Side Tail Pipe** hanger, attach one of the **Hanger Assemblies** using the supplied hardware. **Refer to Figure 8 & 9**.
- 8. Feed the expanded end of the **Passenger Side Tail Pipe** from the rear of the vehicle over the axle and loosely connect it to the **Passenger Side Over Axle Pipe** using a 2 ½" Clamp.
- 9. Move the **Passenger Side Tail Pipe** into approximate position. Using the factory hole provided in the frame located directly above the **Passenger Side Tail Pipe** hanger, attach the second **Hanger Assembly** provided using the supplied hardware.
- 10. Install and adjust the **Exhaust Tips** to suit. Using a 17mm wrench tighten the lock bolt located on each **Exhaust Tip**. **Refer to Figure 10**.
- 11. Tighten all hardware and clamps, starting at the front and working rearward to secure the system. Check along the full length of the exhaust system to ensure there is adequate clearance for fuel lines, vent lines, brake lines, frame, bodywork, suspension, and any wiring, etc. If there is any interference detected, relocate, or adjust to provide adequate clearance. Ensure all clamp connections are secure and components are unable to rotate or slide. Band clamps require approximately 45 lb-ft (60 N-m) of torque. Verify clearances, system security and band clamp torque after 30-60 miles (50-100 km) of driving.
