Installation

- 1. Disconnect negative battery lead.
- 2. Remove the overhead console trim panel [If equipped]. **Refer to Figure 1.**
- Remove the driver-side windshield hinge hardware and discard. Install the Left-Side Light Bracket on top of the hinge [if equipped] and secure with the supplied M8 Washers and M8x35 Bolts. Repeat for Right-Side Light Bracket.
 Refer to Figures 1 and 2.
- Install the Light Bar onto the Light Brackets with the supplied M8x16 Screws. The electrical connector must be on the right-hand side of the SxS, Refer to Figure 3.
- Remove the center console switch panel to allow access to the accessory power studs.
 Refer to Figure 4.
- 6. Remove the glove box and route the Wiring Harness to the center console area. Remove a switch knockout and route the spade terminals through the opening.

 Refer to Figures 4 and 5.



- 7. Connect the spade terminals to the **Switch** following the wiring color/pin assignments. Push the **Switch** into the center console switch panel.
 - Refer to Figures 6 and 7.
- 8. Connect the positive red wire to the accessory power post, and the black wire to the negative ground post. Secure with **M6 Nuts**.
- 9. Reinstall the center console switch panel.
- 10. Drill a ½" hole behind the glove box area and route the **Wiring Harness** into the right side panel, down under the door sill, and up to the right rear cage tube. Trim panel disassembly is required.



- 11. Drill a ½" hole at the top of the right rear cage tube from the interior to aid in routing the Wiring Harness. Refer to Figure 10.
- 12. Feed the bare terminal end of the **Wiring Harness** into the base of right rear cage tube. Once the terminals are visible in the ½" hole drilled in step 11, use a pick or similar to guide the wires up and out of the top of the cage tube.

Refer to Figures 9 and 10.

13. Push the wire terminals through the back of the **Connector**. Be sure to follow the color/pin assignment. Once fully seated, install the green **Wedge Lock** with needle nose pliers to secure the terminals in the connector.

Refer to Figure 11.

- 14. Route the **Wiring Harness** under the roof panel to the **Light Bar** and connect.
- 15. Reconnect negative battery lead.
